Yes, our Apex Kids will truly be "On Top of the World" with a "Newsworthy Summer" to remember.

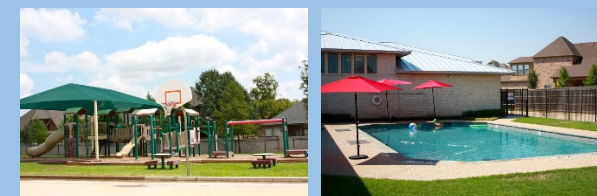
Field Trips
